LAURENTIDE WINERY TAKES TRIPLE GOLD AND BEST OF CLASS AT PRESTIGIOUS DAN BERGER'S INTERNATIONAL WINE COMPETITION

Laurentide Winery has been awarded a Triple Gold medal and Best of Class distinction at the Dan Berger's International Wine and Cider Competition for their 2021 Sauvignon Blanc.

The international competition, in its 35th year, is held in California, and features wines from all over the US including New York and California as well as countries such as Australia.

Laurentide is the only Michigan winery to win a Best of Class at the 2022 competition, and their Sauvignon Blanc won the Triple Gold against a competitive group of 35 Sauvignon Blancs from all across the country and world.

In addition to the Triple Gold for the Sauvignon Blanc, their 2021 Emergence Red and 2021 Pinot Gris were both awarded Silver Medals.

“Our 11th estate vintage of Sauvignon Blanc is a testament to an emerging legacy of great wines being produced in Northern Michigan. Our terroir and team together create history in a bottle!” said Susan Braymer, co-owner of Laurentide.

Laurentide, located in Lake Leelanau, opened in 2012 and is run by owners Bill and Susan Braymer.
